## Cold Weather Tips from Our Safety Manager

The colder weather is approaching and soon, snow will be accumulating on the ground. This is an important time of year to remind our customers about some simple tips that may prevent a fuel run out, pipes from freezing, damage to propane equipment, skipped deliveries or costly labor bills.

- ✓ Please keep your driveway plowed and sanded.
- ✓ Mark your fill pipe or propane tank & regulator with a brightly colored stake.
- ✓ Shovel a path to the fill pipe or propane tank
- ✓ Keep snow and ice from accumulating on the propane tank. Snow and ice buildup on or around the tank can cause a system to shut down or result in a gas leak.
- ✓ Know where your gas supply valve is located.
- ✓ Check your fuel or propane tank levels often if you are not on automatic delivery.
- ✓ Know the day we deliver in your area.

## NO HEAT CHECKLIST

If you experience a **NO HEAT** emergency, take a minute to run through this checklist to see if you can identify the problem.



- ✓ Is the red emergency switch in the on position?
- ✓ Is there enough oil or propane in your tank?
- ✓ Is the thermostat set above the current room temperature?
- ✓ If your thermostat is electronic, check the batteries.
- ✓ Press the **RESET** button on the primary control located on your heating system. **ONLY PRESS ONCE!**
- ✓ Check the fuse boxes for blown fuses or circuit panel for tripped circuits.
